## 2023-2024 Coors Light/Hillview Lanes NO-TAP Rules

1. Nine pins down on first BALL, you receive a STRIKE, all other scoring as in regular bowling.
2. Handicap shall be based on $\mathbf{7 0 \%}$ of $\mathbf{2 0 0}$ for MEN \& 90\% of $\mathbf{2 0 0}$ for WOMEN. Bowlers who average 200 or above or have no previous average will get NO HANDICAP.
3. Use 2022-2023 average, SANCTIONED OR UN-SANCTIONED, unless CURRENT average is $\mathbf{1 0}$ pins or higher for the current bowling season. Out-of-town bowlers must bring proof of average (standing sheet) before cashing in the tournament. ANYONE without PROOF of average MUST enter with a $\mathbf{2 0 0}$ average.
4. Anyone reporting average LOWER than 2022-2023 or current average if $\mathbf{1 0}$ PINS or higher will be DISQUALIFIED and TEAM WILL FORFEIT ALL MONEYS EARNED.
5. Lanes will be assigned by TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR or MANAGEMENT.
6. Teams will bowl $\mathbf{3}$ games across 6 lanes.
7. RE-ENTRIES are PERMITTED
8. The SAME TEAM CAN CASH ONLY ONCE PER DAILY TOURNAMENT. You are permitted to switch partners for the second squad.
9. Tournament Director has the right to REFUSE or RE-RATE any bowler wishing to enter HILLVIEW LANES NOTAP HANDICAP DOUBLES TOURNAMENT.
10. Per USBC rule 400, Youth bowlers are NOT eligible to bowl in this Doubles Tournament.
11. Oil pattern bank is selected by TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR; no pattern will be used in consecutive qualifiers
12. The Natural 300 Pot will continue to build until a real 300 (No No-Tap Strikes) is thrown. The pot can be carried into future seasons until a 300 game is thrown. Handicap does not apply to this pot- must have 12 consecutive real strikes in one game to win the prize. To be eligible, you must have paid the $\$ 5$ buy in at the beginning of the squad in which the 300 game was thrown.
